EXCITING NEWS! CAHS's In-House Surgical Room

The Charlevoix Area Humane Society's in-house Surgical Room is now complete, thanks to the help of many generous donors and a few small grants. After almost five years we have finally found and hired a certified veterinarian technician, Daniel Held! Dan comes to the CAHS with a plethora of experience working with area vets and much more. Dan will be prepping and assisting our two volunteer (semi-retired) veterinarians Dr. Timothy Schacht and Dr. James Mast. With Dan and our current medical liaison Megan Stowe assisting, our volunteer vets are now spaying and neutering our shelter animals! Soon, we will begin addressing the overabundance of feral cat colonies all around Charlevoix County through our TNR (Trap, Neuter, Return) Program. The in-house surgical room will save the shelter thousands of dollars a year, and help us become much more efficient and sustainable in serving our mission, animals and the people who love them in Charlevoix County and beyond.
