Meet Hopper



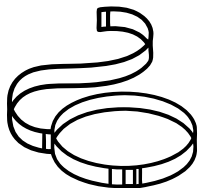

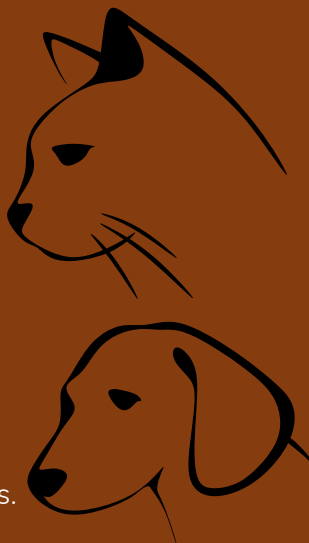
